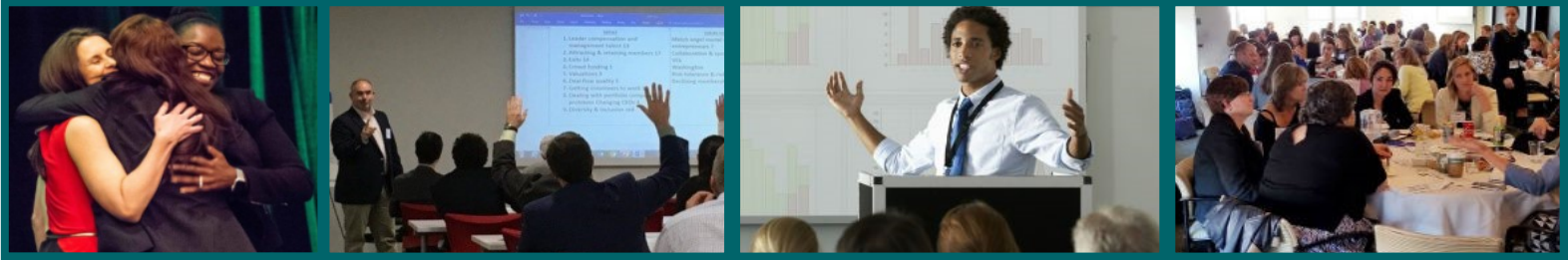

Affiliation Program



ACA seeks affiliation with North American organizations committed to the formation of new angels, angel organizations and enhancing the success of existing angel investing groups as well as those funding early stage companies as a collaboration partner with angels. This commitment has led ACA to create two distinct affiliation categories:

- North American Affiliation is open by invitation to North American (US, Canada, and/or Mexico) and organizations whose organizational or programmatic objectives are in concert with those of ACA.
- Regional Affiliation is open by invitation to regional organizations whose organizational and/or programmatic objectives are in concert with those of ACA.

Please note that all membership / affiliation applications are reviewed by the membership committee for consideration and completed through formal invitation following the application.

Affiliation Benefits:

- Discounts for staff and Board members to attend annual ACA Summits, regional and special interest in-person events (worth \$300 per person for the 2019 ACA Summit).
- Invitation for organizational leadership to attend the fall ACA Leadership Workshop.
- Access for staff and Board members the Members-Only section of the ACA Web site and receipt of special publications that include data and information on specific items such as best practices, member data and deal flow.
- Eligibility for participation in committees that guide the strategic development of the Angel Capital Association.
- Participation in peer to peer collaboration and syndication communities (Life Sciences, Cleantech, Operators, etc.), generally held via conference call and email, but in-person during the annual ACA Summit.
- Reports on US federal and state public policy issues of importance to angel investors.
- Discounts on educational events/ materials, including the growing ACA Education curriculum and free access to ACA Angel Insights Webinar series (\$400 per person savings).
- Access for organizational leadership to select services, such as background checks and free access to the collaboration and syndication Gust platform
- Use of the ACA affiliate logo on group's Web site and printed materials, the right to place the organization's logo on the ACA Web site, and listing on the ACA directory of members and affiliates in North America.
